LICENSE AGREEMENT

This License Agreement (this "Agreement") is made as of this _____ day of May, 2010 (the "Effective Date"), by and between Mountain Laurel Development Group, LP, a Delaware limited partnership, with offices for notice purposes at c/o O'Neill Properties, 2701 Renaissance Boulevard, Fourth Floor, King of Prussia, PA 19406 ("Licensor") and the East Stroudsburg Area School District, with a mailing address for notice purposes at 50 Vine Street, East Stroudsburg, PA 18301 ("Licensee").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Licensor is the fee simple owner of that certain building commonly known as the Mountain Laurel Center for the Performing Arts (the "Center") situated on certain real property located in Lehman Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania identified as Pike County Tax parcel Number 06-0-193.00-01-01 (collectively, with the Center, the "Property"), and

WHEREAS, Licensee and Licensor have agreed in principal to permit Licensee to hold two (2) separate 2010 high school graduation/commencement ceremonies and related activities in the Center (all such activities, collectively, the "Graduation"), subject to the parties formal execution of this Agreement and the timely compliance by Licensee of all of the terms and conditions hereof.

AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration as set forth below, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Recitals. The Recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into this Agreement by reference as if the same had been repeated herein in full.

2.. Right of Entry and License.

Licensor hereby grants to Licensee a non-exclusive, revocable license to enter upon the Licensor's Property and into the Center specifically, solely for the purpose of holding the Graduation, including setting up for and cleaning up after in accordance with the schedule set forth in the following paragraph, it being clearly understood that Licensee shall be solely responsible for leaving the Center and all of the Property in at least the same condition it was in prior to Licensee's entry onto the Property for the purposes set forth herein. Licensee shall remove all trash and garbage from the Center and the Property at Licensee's sole cost and expense. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as granting to the Licensee any property or ownership rights in the Property, or to create a partnership, joint venture or an agency relationship between Licensor and Licensee. Licensor, in its sole discretion, may designate certain areas of the Property which shall be specifically excluded from the applicability of this Agreement and any such areas shall be described in sufficient detail in a writing to Licensee, which such writing shall automatically become a part of this Agreement by reference.

Schedule: Licensee will have the Center available to them on Monday, June 14, 2010 between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm to allow for set-up and pre-ceremony coordination with the Licensor and its representative(s). The Graduation ceremony for the East Stroudsburg High

School North will be on Tuesday, June 15, 2010 and Licensee shall have the Center available to them on that day from 7.30 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. to allow time for set-up, practice, rehearsal, guest and participant arrival/departure, and to allow Licensee time to clean up. The Graduation ceremony for the East Stroudsburg High School South will be on Wednesday, June 16, 2010 and Licensee shall have the Center available to them on that day from 7.30 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. to allow time for set-up, practice, rehearsal, guest and participant arrival/departure, and to allow Licensee time to clean up.

In the event Licensee desires to change the dates set forth above based on an extension of the 2009-2010 school year due to presently unforeseen snow days or other weather conditions, Licensor agrees to cooperate with Licensee in determining alternate dates, in which event the parties agree to amend this Agreement to set forth such newly agreed upon dates (and times, if applicable).

- 3. License Fee. Upon the execution of this Agreement by all parties, and in full consideration of Licensor's agreement to enter into this Agreement, Licensee agrees to pay Licensor the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$15,000.00) for the Graduation.
- 4. Safety Deposit. Upon the execution of this Agreement by all parties, and in full consideration of Licensor's agreement to enter into this Agreement, Licensee agrees to deliver to Licensor a Safety Deposit ("Deposit") in the sum of One Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$1,000.00). The Deposit will be held by Licensor, to insure that the Licensee, its invitees, guests, contractors, agents or other third parties leave the Center and all of the Property in at least the same condition it was prior to Licensee's entry onto the Property for the purposes set forth herein, including but not limited to Licensee's removal of all trash and garbage from the Center and the Property at Licensee's sole cost and expense. If Licensor finds the Center and Property have been restored by the Licensee to at least the same condition it was in prior to the Licensee's entry onto the Property for the purposes set forth herein, Licensor shall return the Deposit to the Licensee within ten (10) business days from the expiration of the term of this Agreement. If Licensor finds the Center and Property have not been restored by the Licensee to at least the same condition it was prior to Licensee's entry onto the Property for the purposes set forth herein, Licensor will provide Licensee photographic evidence of such conditions, and will utilize the Deposit to restore the Center and the Property to the same condition it was in prior to the Licensee's entry onto the Property.
- 5. Insurance Requirements. Within five (5) days of the Effective Date of this Agreement, Licensee shall deliver to Licensor evidence that Licensee, Licensee's invitees, guests, contractors, agents and other third parties, and/or the particular party who intends to enter upon Licensor's Property for the purposes set forth herein, has in effect a fully paid policy of insurance that insures Licensor, the partners of Licensor (Mountain Laurel Development Acquisition Group, LLC and Tamiment Development Group, LP), Licensee, and CapitalSource Finance LLC, against any liability normally covered by a general public liability policy with limits of at least Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) per occurrence of death of, or injury to, any one person or as otherwise reasonably requested by Licensor. The policy(ies) maintained, or caused to be maintained, pursuant to this Section 4 shall insure the contractual liability of Licensee covering the indemnities herein set forth and shall (i) name Licensor, it's partners, and CapitalSource Finance LLC as additional insured parties, and (ii) contain a provision that the insurance provided thereunder shall be primary and noncontributing with any other insurance available to Licensor.
- 6. Licensee's Covenants. Licensee hereby covenants and agrees not to damage, deface or otherwise injure the Center, Property or any part thereof, to comply with all applicable federal,

state and municipal laws, orders, rules and regulations while on or about the Property; and not to disrupt, affect or interfere with the use of the Property by others entitled to use same. This covenant by Licensee includes, but is not limited to, Licensee's obligation to obtain any and all permits or other governmental or quasi-governmental approvals which may be required in connection with the Graduation, at its sole cost and expense.

- 7. Personal Property. Any personal property belonging to Licensee, its invitees, guests, contractors, agents or other third parties, situate upon the Property shall be there at the sole risk of Licensee, and Licensor shall not be liable for damage thereto or theft, misappropriation or loss thereof, except to the extent such damages, theft, misappropriation or theft is attributable to Licensor's gross negligence or willful misconduct.
- 8. Indemnification. Licensee shall indemnify, defend and hold Licensor, its agents, subcontractors, officers, employees, lenders, partners, assigns and successors harmless from and against any and all loss, cost, damage and expense directly arising from Licensee's negligence or misconduct at the Property and any breach of this Agreement, including but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees, professional fees and court costs. The indemnification provided in this Section 7 shall survive the expiration or earlier termination of this Agreement.
- 9. Governing Law; Status and Authority; Entire Agreement; Counterparts; Amendments; Waivers; Assignment. This Agreement shall be governed by the substantive laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The parties hereto each represent and warrant to the other that they are duly organized, validly existing and subsisting under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and under the laws of the State of Delaware, as applicable, and that they have all requisite power and authority to execute and deliver this Agreement and to perform under this Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties relating to the Graduation, there being no other terms or conditions, oral or written, except as herein expressed. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts and each counterpart constitutes an original document. This Agreement may be amended, changed or modified only by written amendment executed by the parties hereto. No waiver of any provision of this Agreement shall be valid unless in writing signed by both parties. Neither party shall assign their interest under this Agreement to any other party without the prior written consent of the other party.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN POCONO FAMILY YMCA AND EAST STROUDSBURG AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT

FOR BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL STUDENT ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

AGREEMENT

This Agreement between Pocono Family YMCA (hereinafter "PFYMCA") and the East Stroudsburg Area School district (hereinafter "the School District") will be effective as of July 1, 2010 and extend through June 30, 2011 and addresses the Agreement between the parties for the provision of a before and after school student enrichment program (hereinafter "the Program"):

WHEREAS, PFYMCA desires to provide a safe, secure and educational before and after school program for students in the East Stroudsburg area; and

WHEREAS, the School District is able to provide classroom and additional space adequate to address the needs of the Program; and

WHEREAS, the Program will provide a service which is beneficial to the students and parents of the School District;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises, and for good and valuable consideration as set forth below, and intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties agree as follows:

1. Use of School District Facilities

The School District hereby grants to PFYMCA a non-exclusive license to enter upon the following school buildings of the School District solely for the purpose of providing a before and after school student enrichment program for student-aged children of the East Stroudsburg Area, and PFYMCA hereby agrees to operate the Program in each of the following school buildings:

- (a) Bushkill Elementary School
- (b) East Stroudsburg Elementary School
- (c) J.M. Hill Elementary School
- (d) Middle Smithfield Elementary School
- (e) Resica Elementary School

The parties agree PFYMCA will be provided classroom space by the School District in each of the aforementioned school buildings as designated by the School District and that the space provided will be appropriate to the needs of the Program. The Program will be operated in correlation with the School District's calendar and will be operational on scheduled school days.

The program will start 6:30 a.m. each school day at each school building, and will continue after school ends until 6:30 p.m.

Under special scheduling circumstances, such as weather related delays in the beginning of a school day or early dismissals of a school day, the PFYMCA will be allowed to continue the program into normal school hours. If a delay in the beginning of a school day becomes a cancellation of the school day, PFYMCA is solely responsible for transporting and relocating the program and all its participants to an alternate location.

The parties agree that the curriculum for the Program will include, but not necessarily be limited to, fitness, nutrition, and tutoring and mentoring of Program participants. PFYMCA is solely responsible for providing professional, caretaking, supervisory and any other staffing needs of the program.

2. Fees

PFYMCA shall provide to the School District, at the conclusion of each calendar month in which the Program made use of School District Facilities, an enumeration of the students participating in the Program. PFYMCA hereby agrees to pay the School District One Dollar and No Cents (\$1.00) per participant in the program, per day of participation. PFYMCA shall provide said enumeration and payment to the School District within 30 days of the conclusion of each calendar month. The School District shall have the right to audit or otherwise question both the enumeration of participants and payment figures at any time, and PFYMCA shall cooperate fully with the School District in said audits.

3.0 General Terms and Conditions

No Further Relationship Implied. PFYMCA hereby certifies that it is a private, independent not-for-profit corporation. PFYMCA shall use its own judgment in determining the method, means and manner of administering the Program and shall be responsible for the administration of the program in accordance with all applicable federal, state and municipal laws, regulations and orders. No relationship other than that which is explicitly set forth in this Agreement is engaged in by either party. Consequently, neither PFYMCA nor any employee, volunteer, contractor or agent of PFYMCA will be considered an employee, volunteer, contractor or agent of the School District at any time, under any circumstances, or for any purpose. Neither the School District nor PFYMCA is the agent of the other, and nor shall have the right to bind the other by contract, or otherwise, except as specifically set forth in this Agreement.

Insurance. PFYMCA shall provide to the School District, within five (5) days of the commencement of this Agreement, proof of General Commercial Liability Insurance in an amount not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence and Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in aggregate, listing the School District as an additional insured.

<u>Indemnity</u>. PFYMCA shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend the School District, its board members, officials, employees, volunteers, agents and attorneys from any and all claims,

complaints, demands, costs, suits, actions, penalties, withheld subsidy, and costs (including, by way of example and not limitation, attorneys fees and litigation costs and expenses) with respect to or arising out of the Program and this Agreement, any activity under the control or FFYMCA and/or any action or inaction by PFYMCA, its officials, employees, agents, contractors or volunteers in connection with this Agreement or any of the students or relatives of students being served by PFYMCA and/or arising out of the School District's enforcement of any term and condition of this Agreement, including costs and attorneys fees incurred by the School District in enforcing this indemnity, hold harmless and defense provision. It is intended that this indemnity, defense and hold harmless provision is to be given its broadest possible meaning and that the School District's board members, officials, employees, volunteers, agents, insurers and employees are expressly considered to be third party beneficiaries with respect to this provision.

Renewal and Termination. This agreement will automatically renew on an annual basis unless the School District or PFYMCA gives written notice to the other party not less than sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of this Agreement that this Agreement shall not be renewed upon its expiration.

This Agreement may be terminated as follows:

- (A) At any time by mutual agreement of the School District or PFYMCA;
- (B) By the School District or PFYMCA if the other party breaches this Agreement or otherwise fails to perform contractual obligations. Thirty (30) days written notice shall be provided upon a breach of this Agreement, during which time the breaching party may cure the breach and continue this Agreement.
- (C) By the School District upon one hundred eighty (180) days written notice to PFYMCA.

Remedies, Waiver of Rights. All remedies of the parties hereto shall be cumulative. No party hereto shall be deemed to have waived any of its rights, powers, or remedies hereunder unless such waiver is in writing and signed by the parties hereto. A failure to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall not be interpreted as a waiver of that provision going forward.

Severability. All agreements and covenants herein contained are severable. In the event that any provision of this Agreement should be held to be unenforceable, the validity and enforceability of the remaining provisions hereof shall not be affected thereby. Any court (or arbitrator) construing this Agreement is expressly granted the authority to revise any invalid or unenforceable provision hereof in order to render same enforceable.

<u>Integration</u>. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the Parties and supersedes any negotiations or prior agreement or understanding of the Parties with respect to the school year 2009-2010. This Agreement may not be modified or amended by any oral statement or alleged course of conduct, but only by a written agreement signed by all Parties. There are no representations, promises, agreements, warranties, covenants or undertakings of the Parties other than those contained herein or in the Exhibits expressly referenced herein.

<u>Force Majeure</u>. The Parties shall not be liable for any failure to perform under this Agreement if such failure is due to causes beyond their reasonable control, including, but not limited to, acts of God or the public enemy, fire, floods, labor disputes, or the judgment or order of any court or government agency.

Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania without regard to conflict of law rules.

<u>Survival</u>. All indemnity, hold harmless and defense provisions of this Agreement shall survive termination of the Agreement.

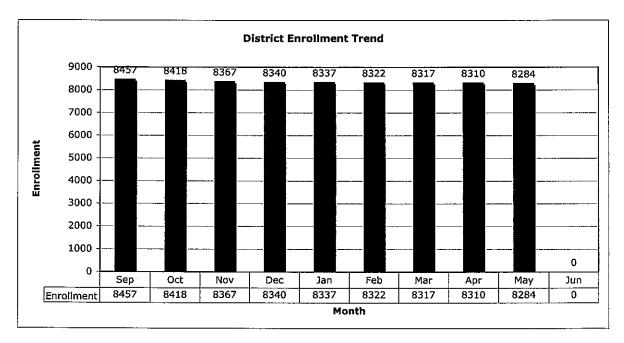
