## Materials

4. **Extra books and notes:** from our school library, public library, or home.

## Directions

1. Use your sources for **NOTES** on these areas. Copy words and phrases from your sources, NOT whole sentences.
  - a) **Location & Land** (*At least 3 facts*)
    1. Where in the country did they live? Describe land features & weather.
  - b) **People** (*At least 3 facts*)
    1. Tell about their clothing, hair, tattoos, language, etc.
  - c) **Village Life** (*At least 3 facts*)
    1. What did their homes look like, and how were they arranged?
  - d) **Food** (*At least 3 facts*)
    1. What did they eat, and how did they gather and prepare it?
  - e) **Society** (*At least 3 facts*)
    1. Jobs of men, women, & children. Also, facts on religion, art, etc.
2. Create a draft of your newspaper. You may read real newspapers for **creative** ideas on how it should look and how you can write it.
3. Make an edited **final copy** of the newspaper on newsprint. Write with **openings and closings** for each section. Add your **own pictures** and color. Have fun with it and **be creative!**
4. **Share** your newspaper with the class. Use **visual aids** if you want.
