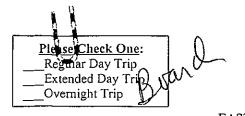

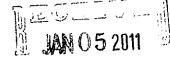

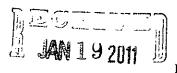

NOTE A - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

As discussed further in 2, these financial statements are presented on the cash basis of accounting. This cash basis of accounting differs from accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP).

1. Financial Reporting Entity

East Stroudsburg Area School District operates as a Pennsylvania School District in East Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania. It operates using a board of nine School Directors as its governing body.

2. Basis of Accounting

The accompanying schedules are presented using the cash basis of accounting. This basis recognizes assets, liabilities, net assets/fund equity, revenues and expenditures/expenses when they result from cash transactions. This basis is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

3. Methodology for Allocating Costs

Costs were allocated according to the amount of bond proceeds used from each of the three series pertaining to the project over the total amount borrowed. For the Series of 2001, 19% was used. For the Series of 2002, 100% was used. For the Series of 2003, 38% was used.

The new and existing costs were allocated as a percentage based on PlanCon-G information.

This is in response to our meeting on Friday, October 8, 2010 and the follow-up school board meeting on December 20, 2010 and your request for a proposal to provide Mechanical and Electrical Engineering Services for the above referenced project. Please disregard our previous proposal dated October 12, 2010.

For purposes of definition in this proposal, East Stroudsburg Area School District Board of Education will be known as the "Client", and as the "Owner", and the subject proposal as the "Project". SAE is the abbreviation for Strunk-Albert Engineering.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Previously we provided a proposal dated July 28, 2010 that included technology, ATC, and emergency generator upgrades. This proposal is to supplement the previous proposal for additional work to be preformed in the original portion of the JM Hill School.

The original building has a basement and two floors. The square footage of these areas are as follows:

 Basement
 19,000 sq. ft.

 First floor
 19,000 sq. ft

 Second floor
 14,000 sq ft.

 Total
 52,000.00 sq. ft.

The overall project scope of work now includes complete replacement of the mechanical systems in the original building and the associated power upgrades needed for this. As a result this will require replacement of the ceilings and additional soffits to conceal piping and duct work.

Although we have not preformed a cost estimate because we do not know the full extent of the work to be performed we feel that the project budget should be \$2M to \$2.5M. Once the project scope is refined the cost estimate can be developed.

We have broken our services into two phases. The first phase is to review and present HVAC options for replacement. This will require us to survey the building to better understand the amount of space available for new equipment, ductwork, and piping. We have also included time for a structural engineer to survey the roof trusses to determine load capacity for possible roof mounted equipment. If the roof can not support new equipment we provided a separate line item for design of additional support steel to supplement the existing.

It is our understanding that because public money is being used to construct the building it will have to follow the Pennsylvania State requirements for prevailing wage rates and separate prime contractors. Therefore, we have included adequate time to develop the drawings and specifications for this bidding method.

2.0 PHASE I: SCOPE OF WORK

2.1 MECHANICAL

- a. Review of HVAC system options that could be installed instead of simply replacing the existing UVs with new. Systems to be reviewed for possible use include: RTUs with VAV, multizone, chilled beams with DOAS, variable refrigerant with DOAS, replacement UVs, vertical packaged classroom HVAC units.
- b. Estimate operating cost savings for two of the most viable HVAC system options.
- c. Take infrared images of the building walls to determine locations for excessive heat loss. Review the wall construction to determine if it is possible to add insulation.
- d. Evaluate the feasibility of replacing the remaining original window in the gym and basement.

2.2 STRUCTURAL

Evaluate the existing roof structure to establish load bearing capacity.

3.0 PHASE II: SCOPE OF WORK

3.1 ARCHITECTURAL

- a. The existing ceilings will have to be removed to install new ductwork and piping. We will develop plans specifications for the ceiling replacement in the areas of the renovation.
- b. Details for chases and soffits to conceal ductwork and piping where needed.

c. Roof flashing details for new roof mounted equipment.

3.2 PLUMBING

- a. Gas piping modifications for the new boilers and rooftop units (if gas fired).
- b. Condensate drain piping for new air conditioning units.

3.3 HVAC

- a. Survey of the building to determine existing conditions and establish available space for new mechanical equipment. (part of previous proposal so not duplicated.)
- b. Demolition plan for existing systems made obsolete by the renovations.
- c. Layout of new HVAC system.
- d. Boiler replacement and conversion from steam to hot water.
- e. ATC (part of previous proposal so not duplicated)

3.4 ELECTRICAL

- a. Demolition plan for existing systems made obsolete by the renovations.
- b. New security system, CCTV, and fire alarm/detection system.
- c. New electrical service if required to accommodate the new air conditioning load. We will analyze demand reading on the electric bill and compare to main breaker and to additional projected load.
- d. New sub-panels and relocation of existing sub-panels where required because of renovations. (We included some new panels in the other proposal. Additional panels will be needed for mechanical equipment.)
- e. Lighting replacement where T-12 fluorescent are currently being used. Because ceilings will have to be removed to install ductwork and/or piping, the ceiling mounted lighting will have to be removed and then reinstalled. Given the age of the light fixtures, the fact that the T-12 lamps are being phased out, and energy savings, it makes sense to replace the light fixtures with new. There is high likelihood that rebates will be available through Act 129 and the electric utility company.
- f. Lighting fixture selection and scheduled on drawing.
- g. Emergency lighting and exit signs.
- h. Temporary disconnect/removal of ceiling mounted devices such as security devices, fire detection devices, speakers, lights, exit signs, etc.

3.5 STRUCTURAL

b. Engineering for design of supplemental supports for roof mounted equipment. This includes framing plan, details, schedules, and specifications, as well as framing details for duct chases and roof openings.

3.6 GENERAL

- a. Site investigation as required to develop the working drawings.

 Reasonable efforts will be made to survey as-built conditions. Hidden conditions or inaccessible spaces may be shown diagrammatic based on assumptions and original design drawings.
- b. Meeting with the School Board or Owner's Rep to review HVAC system options.
- c. Develop a construction phasing plan with the assistance of the Owner.
- d. Front End Bidding Documents: this will include General Conditions, Supplemental Conditions, Bid Form, Bond requirements, sample contract, prevailing wages rates, etc.
- e. Reproducible architectural, structural, mechanical, and electrical plans and CSI format technical specifications/
- f. Design coordination meetings with the Owner.
- g. Opinion of Probable Construction Cost based on Means Data Book information and our experience with recently constructed projects of similar size and use. We have not included a detailed cost breakdown as would be prepared by a Professional Cost Estimator.
- h. Bidding Phase: In-house consultation during the bidding phase that includes answering contractor questions and preparing addendums.
- i. Attend pre-bid meeting.
- j. In-House Construction Administration: Answer RFI's, prepare clarification sketches, and prepare field bulletins.
- k. Construction Review: Twelve (12) construction review meetings with letter report of findings. A construction meeting is defined as a representative of SAE visiting the site to attend a coordination meeting, review the work in progress, punch review, or similar purpose.
- I. Shop Drawing Review.

4.0 ASSUMPTIONS

- a. There are no architectural renovations to the building other than ceiling replacement, chases, and soffits to conceal ductwork and piping.
- b. There are no bathroom upgrades.
- c. There is no work in the 1992 addition.
- d. All submissions, fees, and involvement for code review will be by others.
- e. Electronic files shall remain the property of SAE. Occasionally, if in the best interest of SAE, electronic files may be delivered to the client on disk or by email for the purpose of review only. In no case shall the client release the electronic files or hard copies of the same to third parties. Final drawings and specifications will only be delivered to the client in paper format with authorized SAE signatures.
- f. SAE will provide one final set of drawings and specifications for the Client's use in making additional copies for the contractors that are

bidding the project. (SAE can provide copies as a reimbursable.) SAE will also issue pdf files of the specs and drawings. CAD files will not be released without the user signing a release form.

g. Our anticipated involvement during the construction phase, as reflected in the scope of work is based on the assumption that the work will follow the schedule and the contractors will perform to the terms of their contract. We can not anticipate any involvement beyond this, so our fee does not include services created by the lack of performance of the contractors, unforeseen field issues that arise, additional inspections, or attending job meetings more frequently. If we feel that our involvement is increasing beyond our agreed scope of work we will notify you in writing requesting approval for additional services.

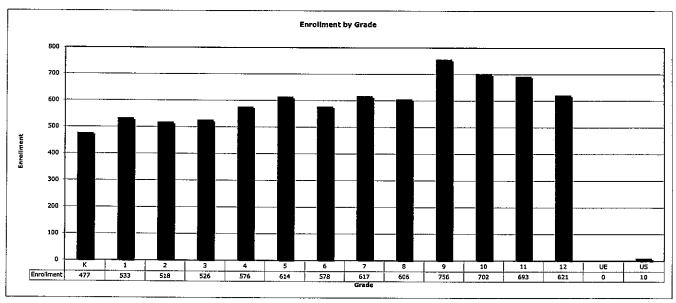

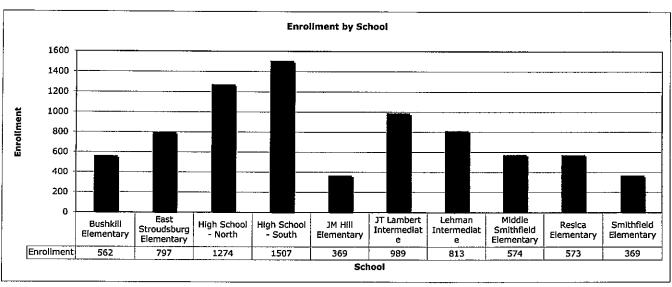

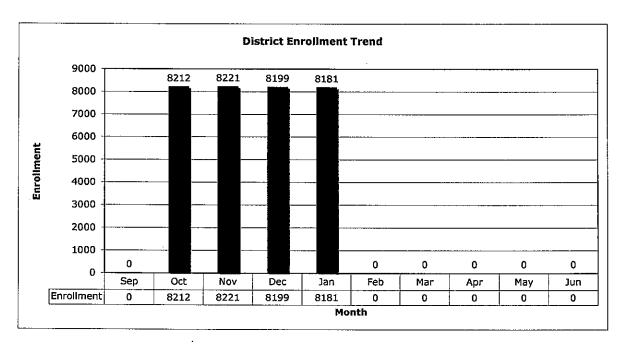
