

Students in Grades 3, 4 and 5 are preparing to take the PSSA tests in reading and math. In addition 4th grade students will be tested in Science and 5th grade in Writing. These very important assessments determine the Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for our school and district. While students cannot study for these standardized tests, you can help us and your child prepare by making sure he/she arrives at school on time and has a full night's sleep and a good breakfast on testing days.
