Our students in grades 3, 4, and 5 have completed the PSSA tests in reading and math. Still ahead - 4th grade students will be tested in Science and 5th grade in Writing. While students cannot study for these standardized tests, you can help us and your child pre-



pare by making sure he/she arrives at school on time and has a full night's sleep and a good breakfast on testing days. Please avoid planning appointments or vacations during this period. We are not able to approve family trips during testing windows.

April 23-27 Science Grade 4

The third round of MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) testing will begin on April 24 through May 1. Students are assessed in reading and math. Scores from the beginning and mid year are compared with these scores to better define student needs.
