3. I attest that the subjects listed in paragraph 4 below will be offered in the English language FOR A MINIMUM OF 180 DAYS OF INSTRUCTION OR A MINIMUM OF 990 HOURS.
4. I attest that the following courses shall be taught:
- a. English
  - b. Science
  - c. Geography
  - d. Social Studies – to include civics, world history, history of the United States and Pennsylvania
  - e. Mathematics – to include general mathematics, algebra, geometry
  - f. Art
  - g. Music
  - h. Physical Education
  - i. Health
  - j. Safety Education – to include regular and continuous instruction in the dangers and prevention of fires
  - k. Other Courses – may be included at the discretion of the supervisor

5. I attest that the education objectives in the home education program are by subject area as attached to this affidavit.

7. I attest that \_\_\_\_\_ has received the health and medical services required by Article XIV of the Public School Code, and I have attached evidence thereof or has a religious exemption under Section 14-1419 of the Pennsylvania Statutes Annotated.

Article XIV requires that every child of school age be given by methods established by the State's Advisory Health Board, an annual vision test, a hearing test, a measurement of height and weight, tests for tuberculosis under medical Supervision and other tests required by the Advisory Health board. Children upon entry into school and in the 6<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grades just have a medical examination and comprehensive appraisal of health by a physician. Children upon entry into school and in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades must have a dental examination by a dentist. A comprehensive health record shall be maintained for each child.

8. I attest that the home education program will comply with Sections 1327 and 1327.1 of the Public School Code.

- n. Section 4302 (relating to incest)
- o. Section 4303 (relating to concealing death of a child born out of wedlock)
- p. Section 4304 (relating to endangering welfare of children)
- q. Section 4305 (relating to dealing in infant children)
- r. A felony offense under Section 5902(b) (relating to prostitution and related offenses)
- s. Section 5903(c) or (d) (relating to obscene and other sexual materials)
- t. Section 6301 (relating to corruption of minors)
- u. Section 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children)
- v. An offense designated as a felony under the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L. 233, No. 64) known as "The Controlled Substance, Drug, Devise and Cosmetic Act"
- w. An out-of-state or Federal offense similar in nature to those crimes listed above.
