# PETITION OF POCONO MEDICAL CENTER PURSUANT TO 72 P.S. §5566b TO THE EAST STROUDSBURG AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT, EAST STROUDSBURG BOROUGH, AND THE COUNTY OF MONROE FOR A REFUND OF REAL ESTATE TAXES ASSESSED AGAINST THE POCONO MEDICAL CENTER HUGHES CANCER CENTER MEDICAL BUILDING

Pocono Medical Center respectfully submits this Petition pursuant to the provisions of 72 P.S. §5566b for a refund of real estate taxes assessed against the Pocono Medical Center Hughes Cancer Center Medical Building. Pocono Medical Center requests that the East Stroudsburg Area School District, East Stroudsburg Borough, and the County of Monroe refund all real estate taxes paid by Pocono Medical Center with respect to the Pocono Medical Center Hughes Cancer Center Medical Building which has been assigned Assessor's Tax Map Identification No. 05-1/3/3/6-1C and PIN #05731117018166C1, and avers the following in support of this Petition that:

1. Your Petitioner is Pocono Medical Center, a Pennsylvania not-for-profit corporation with an office located at 206 East Brown Street, East Stroudsburg, Monroe County, Pennsylvania 18360 ("PMC" and/or the "Hospital").

2. PMC owns and operates a hospital and related medical facilities primarily located along East Brown Street in the Borough of East Stroudsburg, Monroe County, Pennsylvania including, without limitation:

(a) a 231 bed general acute care community hospital which offers a wide range of general and specialty health care services and programs. The licensed beds as of 2013 are allocated for the following services:

In addition, the Hospital operates 30 nursery bassinets;

(b) the Hughes Cancer Center;

The Hospital also maintains Outpatient Diagnostic Centers in East Stroudsburg, Bartonsville, and Mount Pocono, and a Financial Services building on Chestnut Street in East Stroudsburg. In addition, the Hospital maintains the Learning Institute Training Center in the Borough of Stroudsburg.

3. PMC was founded as The General Hospital in 1915 and moved to its current East Brown Street location in 1927. In 1930, The General Hospital merged with the Monroe County Hospital to form the General Hospital of Monroe County. In 1976 the name of the institution was changed to Pocono Hospital. In 1988, the name of the institution was changed to Pocono Medical Center.

4. In 1986 PMC began a five-phase construction/renovation program. The program included the construction of the South Wing, which included a 33-bed medical/surgical unit, and renovation of the East, West, and North Wings. The program was completed in 1990 with the renovation of the pharmacy area and the addition of centralized electrodiagnostic testing suites. In 2001, PMC completed two major renovation projects including a \$5.0 million expansion of the emergency center and a \$1.0 million addition to the cancer center. In Spring 2007 PMC completed the ESSA Heart and Vascular Institute addition. In 2010 PMC commenced construction of the new Hughes Cancer Center which opened on June 18, 2012 and is the subject of this Petition.

5. The following summarizes the major PMC additions and expansions since 1988 to provide better medical care and treatment to the community served by PMC:

- 1988
   The first Hughes Cancer Center opened.

   South Wing opened adding 57,000 square feet of space
- 1988South Wing opened, adding 57,000 square feet of space, including a 22-<br/>bed OB/GYN unit and an adjacent 24-bassinet nursery.
- 1989 West Wing renovation expanded space for Community Health Improvement Program.
- 1990 New facilities provided for respiratory, cardiology and staff development in East Wing.
- 1990 Short-Procedure Unit and Endoscopy Suites expanded in North Wing.
- 1996 Pocono Community Health Center (now Clementine Abeloff Community Health Center) opened.
- 2001 Expansion of Mattioli Emergency Center to a 34-bed, 20,000 square foot emergency care center serving over 50,000 patients annually.
- 2001 The first Hughes Cancer Center installed Intensity Modulated Radiation Therapy technology and completed the second phase of a two-phase project providing space for a new linear accelerator, expanded outpatient chemotherapy unit and a patient support area.

2001	Special Procedures room upgrade at a cost of \$1.0 million providing state of the art interventional radiology care.
2004	Construction of the ESSA Heart and Vascular Institute.
2010	Construction of the new Hughes Cancer Center commenced.
2012	Opening of the new Hughes Cancer Center which is the subject of this Petition.

6. PMC provides a compliment of acute care services to the community which include the following:

Allergy/Immunology Anesthesiology Cardiology Cardiac Cathertization Coagulation clinic Colon/Rectal Surgery Emergency Medicine Family Medicine Gastroenterology

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General Surgery Geriatrics Internal Medicine Interventional Radiology Medical Oncology

Nuclear Medicine

Obstetrics/Gynecology Ophthalmology Orthopedics

Palliative Care Pathology Pediatrics/Adolescent Medicine Perinatology Primary Care Podiatry Psychiatry Radiology Radiation Oncology Spine Surgery Urology Urology Urogynecology Vascular Surgery

Health facilities and supporting services provided by PMC include: Intensive Cardiac Care Unit, Intensive Care Unit, Special Care Unit, Pharmacy, Diagnostic and Therapeutic Radio Isotope facilities, Blood Bank, Histology-Pathology Labs, Electroencephalography, Electromyography, Inhalation Therapy, Premature Nursery, Physical Therapy Department, Psychiatric Inpatient Unit, Organized Outpatient Department, Emergency Department, Social Work Department, Podiatrist Services, Audiology and Speech Therapy Services, Sports Medicine and Stroke Therapy and Abeloff Community Health Center.

7. PMC provides medical care and treatment without charge or at amounts less than its established rates to patients who meet the criteria of its charity care policy. PMC's criteria for charity care eligibility primarily consider the patient's family size and income. These uncompensated charges and the excess of PMC's cost over public assistance program payments are reported as charity care. Because PMC does not pursue collection of amounts determined to qualify as charity, they are not reported as revenue.

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Charity care for the years ended June 30, 2011 and 2012 amounted to \$15,775,943 and \$16,722,648, respectively.

Additionally, PMC sponsors certain other service programs and charity services that provide substantial benefit to the broader community. Such programs include services to populations that need special services and support as well as health promotion and education.

8. The land upon which the new Hughes Cancer Center is located is tax exempt as is the Main Campus.

9. The new Hughes Cancer Center Medical Building is physically attached to the Main Campus by means of the sky bridge over Brown Street. The first Cancer Center which was recently demolished was also tax exempt.

10. PMC petitioned the Monroe County Board of Assessment Appeals for a determination that the new Hughes Cancer building is tax exempt and that Petition was granted by the Board of Assessment Appeals on October 2, 2013 for the tax year beginning January 1, 2014.

11. The Monroe County Assessment Office issued an Interim Property Assessment for the new Hughes Cancer Center building with an effective date of April 30, 2013. The Interim Notice of Property Assessment was mailed to Pocono Hospital but was not specifically addressed to the attention of the Vice President of Finance or to any specific person. The Medical Center has no record of receiving the interim notice and, accordingly, PMC officers were unaware of the Interim Notice of Property Assessment and therefore did not exercise PMC's right to appeal the Interim Notice of Property Assessment or apply for a determination that the new Hughes Cancer Center Medical Building was exempt from real estate taxes. A copy of the Interim Notice of Property Assessment is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A".

12. Based upon the Interim Notice of Property Assessment the following tax bills were issued to Pocono Medical Center creating the following tax liabilities:

(a) Tax Bill 000012CB in the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars Forty-Eight Cents (\$25,422.48) if paid on or before October 31, 2013; a copy of said tax bill is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "B".

(b) Tax Bill 030100 in the amount of Twenty-Six Thousand Seventy-Six Dollars Forty-Two Cents (\$26,076.42) if paid on or before October 31, 2013; a copy of said tax bill is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "C". (c) Tax Bill 001908 in the amount of One Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Eight Dollars Fifty-One Cents (\$156,458.51) if paid on or before November 30, 2013; a copy of said tax bill is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "D".

13. Petitioner respectfully requests the above-referenced taxing bodies refund the taxes paid pursuant to each of the above-referenced Tax Bills in view of the determination of the Monroe County Board of Assessment Appeal that the new Hughes Cancer Center building is tax exempt.

14. PMC's mission and financial ability to fulfill its tax exempt purposes and provide needed medical services to the community served by PMC including, without limitation, the cancer treatment services provided at the new Hughes Cancer Center Medical Building will be substantially and adversely affected if PMC is required to pay the taxes referenced in this Petition.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to 72 P.S. §5566b Petitioner Pocono Medical Center respectfully requests that the East Stroudsburg Area School District, the Borough of East Stroudsburg, and the County of Monroe refund the real estate taxes referenced on the tax invoices attached to this Petition.

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# **Instructions For School Property Tax Payments**

## **Option I: <u>Installment Payments</u>**

## Who is eligible to make installment payments for school property taxes?

All taxpayers are now eligible to pay their school property taxes in three separate installments. Taxpayers that choose to pay their school property taxes in installments are not eligible to receive the two percent (2.0%) discount.

## How does a taxpayer make installment payments for school property taxes?

Taxpayers must remit payment in accordance with the following installment payment schedule:

#### First Payment

If a taxpayer wishes to make installment tax payments, he or she must remit a payment of one-third (1/3) of the base tax amount by August 31<sup>st</sup>.

### Second Payment

The second one-third (1/3) installment tax payment is due on or before October 31<sup>st</sup>. If payment is received on or after November 1<sup>st</sup>, a 10% penalty is added to the installment payment due.

### Third Payment

The third and final one-third (1/3) installment tax payment is due on or before December 31<sup>st</sup>. If the installment payment is not made by December 31<sup>st</sup>, any and all unpaid amounts will be sent to the delinquent tax collector for the district.

## **Option II: <u>Non-Installment Payments</u>**

Taxpayers not wishing to opt into the installment method of payment may continue to pay their school property tax bills based upon the following:

- 2% discount if payment is made on or before September 30<sup>th</sup>
- Full base amount due if payment is made on or before November 30<sup>th</sup>
- 10% penalty if payment is made between December 1<sup>st</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup>

All taxes and penalties not paid by December 31<sup>st</sup> will be considered delinquent and returned to the delinquent tax collector for the district.
