908.1 TITLE I	
1. Purpose	The Title I Program shall provide educational intervention and remediation for students in the elementary schools who meet the established school district criteria for eligibility.
2. Authority	Section 1118 of Title I of ESEA 1994 referring to parental involvement maintains that, in order to receive funds, activities by schools to increase parental involvement are vital to the Title I program. These activities and procedures must be planned and implemented on a continuing basis.
3. Guidelines	<p>Student identification for inclusion in the program shall occur in the fall of the affected school year and shall include teacher recommendations and the utilization of appropriate performance assessments, as described in the Title I application.</p> <p>The school district shall ensure equivalence among its schools in the provision of teachers, administrators and other staff.</p> <p>The school district shall ensure equivalence among its schools in the provision of curriculum materials and instructional supplies.</p> <p>The school district shall maintain a parent advisory committee. The involvement of this committee shall include parental input in the areas of planning, review and improvement of the school district's Title I program.</p> <p>Title I funds shall be used to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Help parents become full partners in their child(ren)'s education by providing materials and training to work with their children.</li> <li>2. Parents shall be notified if a student is eligible for Title I service.</li> <li>3. Ensure that information is sent home regarding educational progress.</li> <li>4. Provide annual informational meetings for parents of Title I students.</li> <li>5. Conduct an annual evaluation of parental involvement.</li> </ol>
