## 106. COURSE GUIDES GUIDES FOR PLANNED INSTRUCTION

1. Purpose Title 22 Sec. 4.4 Pol. 107 Guides shall be prepared for all planned instruction adopted by the Board in order to direct and assist the professional staff toward the attainment of academic standards established for a course of study.

2. Guidelines

Each course guide shall contain, as appropriate to the planned instruction:

- 1. Objectives of the instruction.
- 2. Concepts and skills to be taught.
- 3. Attitudes and a Appreciations to be developed.
- 4. Suggested activities designed to achieve the objectives.
- 5. Suggested methods of instruction.
- 6. Evaluation criteria <u>and methods</u> intended to <u>testevaluate</u> the extent to which learning objectives have been achieved.
- 7. A reading list of supplemental titles for the guidance of teachers.
- 8. Each guide shall be construed as providing a basic framework for the planned instruction. Within this framework, each teacher shall use the course guide in a selective manner best designed to address meet the needs of students. in meeting established standards.
- 3. Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent <u>or designee</u> shall be responsible for the preparation of <del>course</del> guides, and shall develop <u>administrative regulations</u> a <del>plan</del> for such preparation which includes:

1. The participation of appropriate staff members and resource personnel.
