251. HOMELESS STUDENTS

1. Authority 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11431, 11432 SC 1306 Title 22 Sec. 11.18 34 CFR 299.19 The Board recognizes the need to promptly identify homeless students within the district, facilitate their immediate enrollment, and eliminate existing barriers to their attendance and education, in compliance with federal and state law and regulations.

The Board shall ensure that homeless students have equal access to the same educational programs and services provided to other district students.

The Board authorizes the Superintendent to waive policies, procedures and administrative regulations that create barriers to the identification, enrollment, attendance, transportation, school stability and success in school of homeless students.

It is the policy of the Board that no student shall be discriminated against, segregated or stigmatized based on his/her homeless status.

Definitions
 42 U.S.C
 Sec. 11434a
 34 CFR 200.30

Enroll or Enrollment means attending classes and participating fully in school activities.

Homeless students are defined as individuals lacking a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence, which include the following conditions:

- 1. Children and youths who are:
 - a. Sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason;
 - b. Living in motels, hotels, trailer parks or camping grounds due to lack of alternative adequate accommodations;
 - c. Living in emergency, transitional or domestic violence shelters; or
 - d. Abandoned in hospitals.

- 2. Children and youths who have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings;
- 3. Children and youths who are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations or similar settings;
- 4. Migratory children who qualify as homeless because they are living in circumstances described above; and
- 5. School-aged students who have a child(ren) of their own living in houses for school-aged students with a child(ren) if they have no other available living accommodations.

School of origin is defined as the school the student attended when permanently housed or the school in which the student was last enrolled. When the student completes the final grade level served by the school of origin, the school of origin shall include the designated receiving school at the next grade level for all feeder schools.

Unaccompanied youth means a homeless student not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian. This includes youth who have run away from home, been abandoned, or forced out of home by a parent, guardian or other caretaker, or separated from a parent or guardian for any reason.

3. Delegation of Responsibility 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11432 Pol. 103.1, 113 The Board designates the Director of Administrative Services to serve as the school district's liaison for homeless students and families.

The school district's liaison shall ensure outreach and coordination with:

- 1. Local service agencies and other entities that provide services to homeless children and youth and families.
- 2. Other school districts on issues of prompt identification, transfer of records, transportation.
- 3. District staff responsible for the provision of services under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act and the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
- 4. State and local housing agencies responsible for comprehensive housing affordability strategies.

Pol. 906

The school district's liaison shall provide public notice of the educational rights of homeless students in schools, family shelters, public libraries, and soup kitchens. Such notice shall be provided in a manner and form understandable to the parents/guardians of homeless children and youths, and unaccompanied youths.

The district's liaison shall provide reliable, valid and comprehensive data to the Coordinator of Pennsylvania's Education for Children and Youth Experiencing Homelessness (ECYEH) Program in accordance with federal and state laws and regulations.

4. Guidelines 42 U.S.C Sec. 11431, 11432

Best Interest Determination -

In determining the best interest of a child or youth, the district shall:

- 1. Presume that keeping the child or youth in the school of origin is in the child's or youth's best interest, except when doing so is contrary to the request of the parent/guardian or unaccompanied youth.
- 2. Consider student-centered factors related to impact of mobility on achievement, education, health and safety, giving priority to the request of the parent/guardian or unaccompanied youth.
- 3.If, after such consideration, the district determines that it is not in the child's or youth's best interest to attend the school of origin or the school requested by the parent/guardian or unaccompanied youth, the district shall provide the parent/guardian or unaccompanied youth with a written explanation of the reasons for its determination. The explanation shall be in a manner and form understandable to the parent/guardian or unaccompanied youth and shall include information regarding the right to appeal.

Enrollment/Placement

To the extent feasible, and in accordance with the student's best interest, homeless student shall continue to be enrolled in his/her school of origin while she/he remains homeless or until the end of the academic year in which she/he obtains permanent housing. Parents/Guardians of a homeless student may request enrollment in the school in the attendance area where the student is actually living or other schools. If a student is unaccompanied by a parent/guardian, the school district liaison will consider the views of the student in determining where she/he will be enrolled.

Pol. 201, 203, 204, 209, 216

The selected school shall immediately enroll the student and begin instruction, even if the student is unable to produce records normally required for enrollment pursuant to school district policies. However, the school district may require a parent/guardian to submit contact information. The school district liaison may contact the previous school for oral confirmation of immunizations, and the school shall request records from the previous school district, pursuant to Board policy.

Assignment

If the school district is unable to determine the student's grade level due to missing or incomplete records, the school district shall administer tests or utilize appropriate means to determine the student's placement.

Dispute Resolution

If a dispute arises over eligibility, enrollment, or school selection,

- 1. The parent/guardian or unaccompanied youth shall be referred to the district's liaison, who shall assist in the dispute resolution process.
- 2. The student shall be immediately enrolled in the school in which enrollment is sought, pending resolution of the dispute, including all available appeals.
- 3. The parents/guardians shall be provided with a written explanation of the school district's decision, their right to appeal and the procedures to use for the appeal within twenty (20) business days of being notified of the dispute.

A parent/guardian or unaccompanied youth may appeal a district's written decision or file a complaint with the Coordinator of Pennsylvania's Education for Children and Youth Experiencing Homelessness Program.

Education Records

Information about a homeless student's living situation, shall be treated as a student education record subject to the protections of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), and shall not be deemed to be directory information.

Comparable Services

42 U.S.C. Sec. 11432 SC 1306 Homeless students shall be provided services comparable to those offered to other school district students including, but not limited to, transportation services; school nutrition programs; career and technical education; preschool programs; ; and educational services provided under Title I or similar state or local programs for which students meet eligibility criteria; such as programs for English Language Learners; programs for students with disabilities; and programs for gifted and talented students.

Transportation

42 U.S.C Sec. 11432 SC 1306 The school district shall provide transportation for homeless students to their school of origin or the school they choose to attend within the school district.

251. HOMELESS STUDENTS - Pg. 5

If the school of origin is outside school district boundaries or homeless students live in another school district but will attend their school of origin in this school district, the school districts shall agree upon a method to apportion the responsibility and costs of the transportation.

Training

The district's liaison shall participate in professional development programs and other technical assistance activities offered by the Coordinator of Pennsylvania's Education for Children and Youth Experiencing Homelessness Program.

The district's liaison shall arrange professional development programs for school staff, including office staff.

School personnel providing services to homeless children and youths, including school enrollment staff, shall receive professional development and support to:

- 1. Improve identification of homeless children and youths and unaccompanied youths;
- 2. Understand the rights of such children, including requirements for immediate enrollment and transportation; and
- 3. Heighten the awareness of, and capacity to respond to, the educational needs of such children.

1. Authority 20 U.S.C. 6311, 6312 42 U.S.C. 675 To ensure the educational stability of children in foster care, the Board requires the district to collaborate with the local children and youth agency and other school districts.

2. Definitions

Additional costs means the difference between what the district spends to transport a resident student to his/her assigned school and the cost to transport a child in foster care to his/her school of origin.

45 CFR 1355.20

Foster care means twenty-four (24) hour substitute care for children placed away from their parents or guardians and for whom the child welfare agency has placement and care responsibility. This includes, but is not limited to, placements in foster family homes, foster homes of relatives, group homes, emergency shelters, residential facilities, child care institutions, and pre-adoptive homes. A child is in foster care in accordance with this definition regardless of whether the foster care facility is licensed and payments are made by the state, tribal or local agency for the care of the child, whether adoption subsidy payments are being made prior to the finalization of an adoption, or whether there is federal matching of any payments that are made.

School of origin is the school in which a child is enrolled at the time of placement in foster care. If a child's foster care placement changes, the school of origin would then be considered the school in which the child is enrolled at the time of the placement change.

3. Delegation of Responsibility

The Board designates the Director of Administrative Services to serve as the district's point of contact for children in foster care.

20 U.S.C. 6311

The district's point of contact shall coordinate with:

- 1. Local children and youth agency to:
 - a. Establish formal mechanisms to ensure that the district is promptly notified when a child enters foster care or changes foster care placements.

- b. Develop a protocol on how to make best interest determinations; and
- c. Develop and coordinate transportation procedures.
- 2. Other school districts on issues of transfer of records, transportation and other inter-district activities.

3. Guidelines

Enrollment/Placement

20 U.S.C. 6311

A child in foster care shall continue to be enrolled in his/her school of origin unless there is a determination that it is not in his/her best interest to attend the school of origin.

Best Interest Determination -

The best interest determination shall be made in accordance with federal and state laws and regulations, court orders, and established local procedures.

In determining whether it is in a child's best interest to remain in his/her school of origin, all factors relating to a child's best interest shall be considered, including the appropriateness of the current educational setting and proximity of foster care placement.

Documentation related to the best interest determination shall be kept in the student's education record.

Enrollment -

Policy 200

When a child in foster care is placed in the district and seeks enrollment in district schools, the district's point of contact shall:

- 1. Ensure the child is immediately enrolled and attending school, even if the records normally required for enrollment pursuant to district policies are not available.
- 2. Immediately contact the school last attended by the child to obtain relevant academic and other records.

Dispute Resolution -

If a dispute arises over the appropriate school placement for a child in foster care, to the extent feasible and appropriate, the child shall remain in his/her school of origin, pending resolution of the dispute.

	Student Who Has Exited Foster Care -

1. Purpose	The Board recognizes that individuals, businesses and community organizations may wish to contribute additional funds, supplies and equipment to enhance or extend the programs in the schools.
2. Authority SC 216	The Board or designee has the authority to accept gifts and donations made to the school district or to any school of the school district on its behalf.
SC 216	The Board reserves the right to refuse to accept any gift that does not contribute to achievement of school district goals or when such ownership would adversely affect the school district.
SC 216	Any gift accepted by the Board or its designee shall become school district property, may not be returned without Board approval, and is subject to the same controls and regulations as are other school district properties.
	The Board shall be responsible for the maintenance of any gift it accepts, unless otherwise stipulated.
SC 216	The Board shall make every effort to honor the intent of the donor in the use of the gift, but it reserves the right to utilize any gift in the best interests of the school district's educational program.
	In no case shall acceptance of a gift be considered an endorsement by the Board of a commercial product, business enterprise, or institution of learning.
SC 216 Pol. 706	All gifts shall be recorded in the appropriate inventory listing and property records.
3. Definition	For the purpose of this policy, the term gift is defined to be any monetary or non-monetary contribution to the school district. Nonmonetary contributions may be in the form of materials, equipment, land, etc. Monetary contributions may include donations in support of programs or activities in an individual school or on a district-wide level and scholarship funds.

4. Guidelines

All proposals for gifts to the school district or individual schools must be brought to the Finance Committee for review and recommendation to the Board.

Proposals must include the purpose to which the gift is to be applied, the amount of the gift (for gifts-in-kind, an estimated value should be provided), and the timeframe in which the gift will be used.

Scholarships

For the purposes of establishing a scholarship, proposals must include:

- 1. The name of the scholarship.
- 2. The reason for its establishment (e.g. in memory of someone, in honor of someone, in recognition of someone or something, etc.)
- 3. The purpose to which it is applied (i.e. what are the funds to be used for by the recipient).
- 4. The selection criteria to be used and the procedure for making the selection.
- 5. The amount to be awarded and number of recipients.
- 6. May principle be expended or only interest?

All contributions must be made payable to the East Stroudsburg Area School District. Contributions to scholarships must identify the name of the scholarship fund on the check. All checks must be sent to the attention of the Chief Financial Officer.

Scholarships funds will be invested as part of the district's scholarship pool and will earn interest based on its share of the investment pool.

District officials who are approached by donors wishing to make a gift to the district should discuss the potential gift with the Superintendent and the Chief Financial Officer before a proposal is brought to the Finance Committee.

I. BACKGROUND

- 1. This is a tax assessment appeal concerning the property known by Tax Parcel No. 05/119021, located in the Borough of East Stroudsburg, Monroe County, Pennsylvania (hereinafter "the Property").
- 2. The East Stroudsburg Borough was properly served with this petition, but has declined to enter an appearance or otherwise participate in this matter.

- 5. The Parties agree that the assessed value for the Property for the 2017 tax year shall be \$232,100.

The parties anticipate that the original 2017 school tax bill (concerning the July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018, school district fiscal year) will reflect taxes due based on the assessment revised per the terms of this Stipulation.
- 7. All parties agree that the said 2017 assessment shall remain in place for all subsequent tax years until such assessment is changed by lawful means.
- 8. The undersigned counsel executing this Stipulation on behalf of the parties warrant and represent that each is duly authorized to execute this Stipulation on behalf of such party.
- 9. This Stipulation to Settle and corresponding Court Order shall be binding on the undersigned and the undersigned clients, and any and all successors in interest.
 - 10. All parties hereto shall bear their own costs and expenses.
- 11. This Stipulation to Settle incorporates the entire understanding of the agreement between the parties.
 - 12. This Stipulation to Settle may be executed in counterparts.
