A question of what policies other districts not in our area have implemented that provide a broader scope of acceptable dress?

Committee should address the merit/demerit process. Create a way to "erase/drop" any dress code related demerits. Also, look at the consequences and create a more "reasonable" consequences list. Suggested working within a specific time period to create removal of demerits, i.e. by marking period, etc.

Better communication of policy and related items and consequences. FAQs are not the best form of communication.
