V. ANNOUNCEMENT OF EXECUTIVE SESSION(S)

a. An Executive Session was held this evening at 5:30 p.m. before this meeting for the purpose of discussing personnel, litigation and negotiations.

VI. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

ACTION BY THE BOARD:

Motion was made by George Andrews to adopt this agenda for January 28, 2019, as submitted, with the Board of Education reserving the right to add to the agenda, and take further action on any items raised in executive session where immediate action on such items is considered to be in the best interest of the District. Motion was seconded by Keith Karkut.

Motion was made by Debbie Kulick to add two field trips to the agenda. Motion was seconded by Keith Karkut and carried unanimously, 9-0.

Motion was made by Keith Karkut to add the discussion of restructuring by having two work sessions a month as opposed to committee meetings. Motion was seconded by Rich Schlameuss and carried unanimously, 9-0.

Motion including additions on the agenda was carried unanimously, 9-0.

VII. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

ACTION BY THE BOARD:

Motion was made by George Andrews to approve the minutes of the December 3, 2018 and December 17, 2018 Board meetings. Motion was seconded by Keith Karkut and carried unanimously, 9-0.

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VIII. REPORTS

a. Monroe Career & Technical Institute Update

Mr. Keith Karkut said the district has two older vehicles that they were looking to dispose of and would have gotten a minimal value for them. Instead, the district will be donating them to MCTI for the students to use in class. Mr. Larry Dymond said if anyone is interested in attending the Skills USA, where MCTI students compete, it will take place in Allentown on January 30th. Dr. Riker said that the Skills USA competition date was moved to January 31st due to the forecast for inclement weather.

b. Colonial IU 20 Update

Mr. Robert Huffman said the IU 20 meeting did not occur due to inclement weather. However, he distributed to all Board members an invitation to the Excellence in Education Awards and Merit Scholar Recognition Ceremony scheduled for Thursday, April 25, 2019. Please return it to the IU 20 if you plan to attend.

c. Property/Facilities Committee Update

Mr. Wayne Rohner said that the Property/Facilities Committee met on January 3rd.

Items requiring action were as follows:

- 1. CSI Proposal for PA System upgrade at Bushkill Elementary School in the total amount of \$24,853.60 for a zone paging TCU solution, which includes a desktop microphone option at a cost of \$1,062. Also, CSI Proposal for PA System upgrade at Middle Smithfield Elementary School in the total amount of \$22,964.25 for zone paging TCU Solution and a desktop microphone option at a cost of \$1,062.
- 2. Security cameras for The Learning Center and South Bus Garage from Integra One for Cisco Meraki cameras, which includes a ten-year subscription license in the total amount of \$24,787.00.

Items for Discussion:

- 1. D'Huy Engineering gave a timeline regarding the North Campus' roof project. The Committee will receive final bid documents at the next meeting for review and discussion.
- 2. The J. T. Lambert and High School South stage floors were placed on the agenda for discussion. The Committee would like the construction plans by the next meeting.
- 3. An update on the Smithfield Elementary School hot water tank that was temporarily repaired last spring. The Committee needs an update of when Superheat will complete this job.

Miss Jessika Gort, High School South, said the following occurred during this month:

- 3. The Junior States of America Club had a Jazz Group come into the school to give a performance.
- 4. Congratulations to the music students in District Orchestra and band who qualified for the Region Competition. Good luck to the students who will be participating in the District-wide Festival.
- 5. Show stoppers will be held this Friday and Saturday at 7:00 p.m. at the J. T. Lambert Intermediate School. Students from all grades and all schools will be performing. The tickets are \$10 per person, which will serve as a fundraiser for J. T. Lambert Intermediate music students for when they attend musical events.

g. 2019-2020 Budget Draft

Mr. McIntyre presented the first draft of the 2019-2020 budget as follows:

Revenues which equal 68.1% Local, 27.7% State, 2.7% Federal and 1.4% Other. Local Revenues come from real estate taxes. They depend on the assessed values, collection rate and millage rates in Monroe County (Monroe) and Pike County (Pike). Currently the millage rates are 177.86 for Monroe and 123.66 for Pike. Next year there will be a slight decrease for Monroe and Pike will have no tax increase. Mr. McIntyre also provided an eight-year millage history, which shows that Monroe County millage has decreased by 4% and in Pike County the millage decreased by 5.22. Revenues have increased due to reverse appeals, which help offset expenses. This budget includes a zero tax increase. The State revenues come from the Governor's budget, which hopefully will be announced next week. The Basic Education Funding Formula is for new money only. The State currently has a large deficit. The Governor is school-district friendly; therefore, the district may see more funds. The Federal funds come from federal grants, i.e. Title I, Title II and Title III. Currently, the funding is unknown. The Other Revenue comes from proceeds from financing leases and sale of fixed assets such as the Bus Buy-back program. The current revenues total \$155,806,468 and the estimated revenues for 2019-2020 are \$159,417,071, which is a 2.26% increase.

Expenses include wages and benefits at 70% and debt service 11%. 81% of the district's costs are fixed. About 20% of the district's cost are variable, such as supplies, books, utilities, etc. Some costs are not directly controllable by the district such as special and alternative education services. Wages and benefits are projected to increase by 7.7 million dollars. Non-wage and benefit expenses are projected to increase by \$741,226. Total expenses for this year equal \$155,797,475 and projected to be for 2019-2020 \$164,326,728, which is a 5.19% increase.

Mr. Keith Karkut asked when the County's reassessment will affect the budget, this year or next year. Mr. McIntyre said he believes it would affect next year's budget. Mr. Brown said our local revenue by design will be identical.

h. D'Huy Engineering

Mr. Josh Grice said that he was contacted regarding an urgent repair on the water heater at High School North. He brought an update, which included the options and estimated costs.

He said the current heater is a single domestic heater. It appears to be beyond repair. Existing Conditions on the 2500 Gallon, Oil Fired 1,600,000 BTU/Hr input heater is starting to leak, poly-clad lining showing damage, and storage tank showing deterioration due to age; therefore, replacement or repair is required. New equipment needs to fit in the mechanical room. Since there is only one tank all functions go down all at once. Propane and/or oil can be used.

Four options:

- 1. Options #1 Integral Tanks (Oil fired or dual fuel) Single, or two heaters @50% oil fired water heaters of equal capacity. There is an upfront cost for propane. The work can be accomplished with a two-heater arrangement.
- 2. Option #2 Integral Tanks (Propane Condensing) Two heaters @ 50% propane fired condensing water heaters of equal capacity. Integral storage vessel with higher efficiency condensing gas boiler with propane plus upfront cost.
- 3. Option #3 Remote Heaters with Tank (Oil Fired or Dual Fuel) Single oil or dual fuel boiler with six indirect water to water tank heaters. Two heaters.
- 4. Option #4 Remote Heaters with Tank (Propane Condensing) Two @50% propane fired condensing water heaters of equal capacity and four storage tanks, only propane option.

Summary Capital Outlet

Option 1 would cost \$120,000. Option 3 would cost about \$245,000 for multiple boilers with remote storage vessels. Mr. Grice said his recommendation is to go with some type of remote storage vessel solution due to the lead time. Packaged equipment takes about six weeks or more. The storage vessels are a quick lead time. They can be temporarily piped into the storage lines until permanent units are installed.

Mrs. Lisa VanWhy asked if it would be best to have units operating with two different types of fuels. Mr. Grice said dual fuel can go from oil to propane and vice versa. Mrs. Vanwhy asked would the two boilers operate at 50% each. Mr. Grice said the multiple boiler option can function separately. Mr. Grice said multiple boilers are options 3d or 4. Mr. Karkut asked how does the fact that we are buying propane for the buses help with this cost. Mr. Sutjak said we are paying about 70 cents on propane but the district currently receives a rebate for the buses. Mr. Karkut said if the district is going to buy more propane, the cost may be less in the bid process. Mr. Grice said that would be a separate bid process. The district is currently using oil. Mr. Karkut

asked what the option is of switching from one system to the other and is there a cost? Mr. Grice said some systems may mandate to switch from natural gas one to the other duel source due to temperature, but this is not the case with propane, but it might be possible. Mr. Andrews asked if Mr. Grice is recommending storage tanks. Mr. Grice said he is due to having the quickest turnover. Mr. Brown said that Mr. Grice mentioned that the heater may go at any moment. Mr. Grice said that this is the feedback that he received from the vendor, Superheat who is servicing this equipment. Mrs. VanWhy asked for the timeframe to receive the boilers if the district choses Option 3d or 4. Mr. Grice said six weeks but the separate storage tanks are a few days. There is no need to do the typical three-week advertising process but specs and bids are needed and the process would take about 4 weeks. Mr. Grice said temporary repairs can be made but it would end up costing the district more money. Mr. Grice said from the feedback that he received tonight, it sounds like the Board is in favor of dual fuel tanks. Mr. Dymond discussed with Mr. Grice what he investigated on this issue. Mr. Grice said the Board can chose a single fuel, only gas, if that is what they want. He is happy to look at other options but the Board has to decide if it will be multiple fuel sources or just one. Mr. Karkut asked if the rest of the district uses oil. The district is. Mr. Karkut asked what is the game plan here? Mrs. VanWhy said the Board has to make a decision tonight.

Public Participation:

Mrs. Bear asked what the guarantee is on the equipment once it is installed. Mr. Grice said the current unit had a twenty-year guaranty, which is reasonable. The guarantee depends on the components. Mrs. Bear asked which one will last longer. Mr. Andrews said with one single unit when it is out, it's out. With a dual unit if one is out the other still functions and overall maintenance is less.

Ms. Maria Hopkins asked if there will be labor and parts guarantee for one year. If the district wants additional guarantee, they will have to ask for it upfront but it would cost more.

Mr. Robert Eden asked what the down time would be for the installation of the water heater. Mr. Grice said it can be completed over a weekend. Mr. Eden asked what will take six weeks to complete. Mr. Grice said the boiler equipment will take about six weeks to arrive but the tanks will arrive sooner and can be installed with the current equipment.

i. Emergency Medical Responder Dual Enrollment Program

Mr. Ryan Moran said that he along with Mrs. Piperato are here tonight to share with the Board and community members a new course offering, Emergency Medical Responder, to the students beginning in the spring. He thanked Ms. Debbie Kulick for her assistance and work in bringing this opportunity to the school district. In addition, he thanked the administrative team at both high schools as well as the counselors for helping promote and register students in such a short time. There are 31 student who will be participating. This course is part of a larger plan to provide an increase amount of relevant career path oriented courses for the students. This course provides the opportunity for students to learn in specific areas such as EMT, First Responder and along those lines. They will be able to complete the course by obtaining a certificate in the field of Emergency Medical Responder.

A handout was distributed. Mrs. Piperato said that the Superintendent and the Assistant Superintendent challenged the staff to provide an education that the students in ESASD currently need. The five main areas that they are looking at are:

- Keep our students physically safe and teach them how to treat each other safely.
- Emotionally support our students and teach them how to treat each other with emotional care
- Help students discover who they are as learners so they can design their own college or career path
- Help them find solutions to any academic obstacles standing in the way of that path
- Help them design learning experiences during high school that will give them an advantage in whatever they want to pursue after high school.

It's not about content knowledge but what you do with what you know. More conversations will follow in the coming months, because this is a long-term system process change. They will work together to see what evidence they have collected to ensure that it is working. It will take time to set up. The EMR course meets both things, students applying what they learn in their science classes and it helps them to be competitive.

Ms. Kulick thanked them for offering this course. This is the only district that currently offers this course to the students. The EMR course will help with future firefighters and other career opportunities. This type of course has proven to change the life of a former student.

Mr. Karkut asked what credits the students will receive for taking this course. Mr. Moran said that it will serve as a dual enrollment. They will earn a high school credit and 3 credits for Northampton Community College and other colleges, too.

She said that PTOs and other organizations should not be charged what they are being charged such as for the use of the facility and staff. Mr. Huffman said that they spoke about all details at the Policy Review Committee meeting. Mrs. VanWhy said the issue was resolved. Mr. Schlameuss said that fees will not be charged with certain restrictions. The Board, at the next meeting will adopt the revised policy, which will be posted on the website.

Mr. Karkut said that his addition to the agenda was for the Board members to discuss the removal of committee meetings and have two monthly work sessions instead.

Mr. Karkut said that paper is being wasted because items are discussed in both committees and administration has to attend both committee meetings. Mrs. VanWhy said that some items from the Property/Facilities Committee meeting do not necessarily get discussed at the Finance Committee Meeting. The Policy Review Committee meeting is also separate. To have meetings to discuss all of those items would mean that the Board would have to have one general meeting and two more. Mr. Karkut said most Board members, except for him, are part of two meetings anyway. Mrs. VanWhy said that committee meetings are about 2 hours but having more Board meetings would make them longer. Mr. Schlameuss said that the Board meetings run shorter because of the committee meetings. Mr. Karkut said the committees are advisory and should not be approving. Mrs. VanWhy said that the committee are only recommending and the entire Board approves. Mr. Karkut said he is trying to make the Board more transparent and not have to wait for the regular meeting to discuss the items. For instance

they could have discussed the water heater issue that is occurring. Mrs. VanWhy said that this particular item is a one-time issue. Mr. Huffman said that if anyone has a question on the agenda they get an answer in a few minutes without attending the meetings for hours. He trusts that the Committee members discussed it and ironed out the problems. Mr. Karkut said the meetings would not be long because they would combine the information into two meetings. They are asking the four committee members to make the decision of nine. Mr. Schlameuss said the committees are only recommending not approving. Mrs. Vanwhy said everyone should think about this suggestion and then it can be revisited at a later time.
