

ADMINISTRATIVE

**206-AR-1: ASSIGNMENT WITHIN THE DISTRICT**

Under the authority of Policy 206 – Assignment Within the District, the Superintendent has established the following guidelines regarding the assignment of students within the district.

**Students Who Move From a Building Attendance Area, but Remain School District Residents**

A student shall be deemed to have “displayed acceptable behavior and academic progress” when:

1. The student has no Level III or IV disciplinary infractions as defined by the Code of Student Conduct within the past 45 school days and;
2. The student has not been identified as a candidate for retention under the provisions of Policy 215.

If the administration grants permission for a student to remain in the current school through the end of the school year in accordance with these guidelines, such permission shall be immediately revoked when:

1. The student receives a Level III or IV disciplinary infraction as defined by the Code of Student Conduct, or;
2. The student is identified as a candidate for retention under the provisions of Policy 215.

**Change of Assigned Elementary/Intermediate School**

A student shall be deemed to have “excessive absenteeism, tardiness, or late pick-ups” when:

1. The student has accumulated more than 9 unlawful absences in the current school year, or;
2. The student has accumulated more than 300 unlawful tardy minutes in the current school year, or;
3. The student has been picked up later than 10 minutes after the end of the school day on more than five (5) occasions in the current school year.

If the administration grants permission a change of assigned elementary/intermediate school in accordance with these guidelines, such permission shall be revoked:

1. At any time the student is deemed to have “excessive absenteeism, tardiness, or late pick-ups” as defined above, or;
2. At the end of the school year in which the student no longer meets the qualifications set forth in Policy 206.
