Sec. 71837973 Pol. 818</u></p>	<p><u>delivery systems, an electronic cigarette, a cigar, a pipe and a hookah.</u></p> <p>3. <u>Any product containing, made or derived from either:</u></p> <p>a. <u>Tobacco, whether in its natural or synthetic form; or</u></p> <p>b. <u>Nicotine, whether in its natural or synthetic form, which is regulated by the United States Food and Drug Administration as a deemed tobacco product.</u></p> <p>4. <u>Any component, part or accessory of the product or electronic device listed in this definition, whether or not sold separately.</u></p> <p><u>The term tobacco product does not include the following:</u></p> <p>1. <u>A product that has been approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration for sale as a tobacco cessation product or for other therapeutic purposes where the product is marketed and sold solely for such approved purpose, as long as the product is not inhaled.</u></p> <p>2. <u>A device, included under the definition of tobacco product above, if sold by a dispensary licensed in compliance with the Medical Marijuana Act. Federal law requires the district to maintain a drug-free workplace, at which marijuana of any kind is prohibited.</u></p> <p>The Board prohibits use of tobacco, nicotine and nicotine delivery and vaping products, <u>including the product marketed as Juul and other e-cigarettes</u> by <u>district employees and contracted personnel at any time</u> in a school building and on any property, <u>school buses, vans and vehicles that are owned, leased or controlled by the school district; or on property owned leased or controlled by the school district.</u></p> <p>The Board <u>also</u> prohibits use of tobacco, nicotine and nicotine delivery and vaping products, <u>including the product marketed as Juul and other e-cigarettes</u> by employees at school sponsored activities that are held off school property.</p> <p><u>This policy does not prohibit possession of tobacco and vaping products, including the product marketed as Juul and other e-cigarettes, by district employees and contracted personnel of legal age.</u></p> <p><u>The Board deems it to be a violation of this policy for any district employee or contracted personnel to furnish a tobacco or vaping product, including the product marketed as Juul or any other e-cigarette, to a student.</u></p>
