109. RESOURCE MATERIALS

1. Purpose SC 801, 803

Policy reflects the philosophy and mission statement of the East Stroudsburg Area Schoo District. The Board shall provide instructional and evaluative materials to implement the school district and school educational goals and academic standards.

2. Definition

Resource materials shall include nonfiction and fiction books, magazines, reference books, supplementary titles, multimedia and digital materials, maps, library books, software, and all other instructional material.

3. Delegation of Responsibility SC 803 The Superintendent or his/her designee shall after consultation with the teaching staff, librarians, and resource committee shall be responsible for the selection and recommendation of all resource materials. No adoption, change or purchase of materials shall be made without his/her recommendation, and approval by a two-thirds vote of the Board.

The Superintendent shall develop and after review and approval by the board implement selection procedures for resource materials.

<u>Resources Committee:</u> Committee is to consist of education committee, Librarians, teachers, students, and community members. Their purpose is to evaluate all resources as to the appropriateness, taking into account such areas as CULTURAL, ETHNIC, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, RELIGION and SOCIAL DIVERSITY.

Pol. 105.1	A list of resource materials provided by the district shall be maintained by the Superintendent or his/her designee and shall be available to Board members, district staff, students, parents/guardians and community members on a timely basis as requested.
