b. High School North Baseball Field - Daryle Miller

Daryle stated this is for the North Varsity Baseball field. The field needs to be regraded or excavated to remove the lip that is causing issues. This field is roughly 20 years old. We reached out to three vendors, but Rutledge would not send us their quote. This is a Capital Budget item.

Last month's Property and Facilities meeting, Jason Gullstrand asked if the District still performs some kind of air quality testing. Environmental Services has LaBella perform air tests annually, and they are very thorough and provide thorough reports.
